



Reddy project nearly ready

CONSTRUCTION on Redcliffe's Waterview development is almost complete, with the apartments expected to be finished by early next month.

As the builders put the final touches on the 48-residence complex, developers Frexway Pty Ltd have experienced increasing interest from

the local homebuyer market.

Ray White Project Marketing's Graeme Sharp said since its launch late last year, three of Waterview's residences had sold, with buyers attracted to the apartment's house-sized layouts.

"The apartments are designed like a home, with three big bedrooms with built-in wardrobes, two full-sized

bathrooms and a full-sized laundry," Mr Sharp said.

The apartments, which are priced from \$385,000, are only 100m from the beach in one of Redcliffe's most popular residential areas.

Each residence has a balcony, with many featuring views to Moreton Bay, as well as secure car parking.

Apartments on the top floor also

have rooftop decks.

Interior features include airconditioning and granite bench tops, two-pak cabinetry and European appliances in the kitchens.

Mr Sharp said residents of the complex would have access to a swimming pool, private gymnasium and communal lounge.
